AUTHORIZING SUPPORT FOR ATLANTIC COUNTY
LOCAL EFFICIENCY ACHIEVEMENT PROGRAM (LEAP)
GRANT FOR CENTRAL DISPATCH

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey has allocated \$150,000 within each county for a statewide total \$3.15 million in Local Efficiency Program (LEAP) funds to promote innovation among peer local units across New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Community Affairs, Division of Local Services (DLGS) administers the LEAP grant program; and

WHEREAS, the LEAP Challenge Grant exists to challenge municipalities and counties to collaborate on more extensive partnership and collaborations to produce efficiencies through shared services; and

WHEREAS, County of Atlantic and City of Margate City, have determined to apply for a LEAP Challenge Grant through the State of New Jersey Local Efficiency Achievement Program in the amount of \$150,000; and

WHEREAS, the County of Atlantic has agreed to be the lead agency in this program; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of County of Atlantic is acknowledging and accepting the responsibility of acting as applicant and administrator for this grant on behalf of all participating local units; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey has made LEAP Grants available to assist local units to study and develop new shared services initiatives; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the project submitted in this grant application is intended to provide benefits to the participant local units' residents through sharing of Grant for Atlantic County Central Dispatch.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the governing body of the City of Margate City, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey, does hereby make application for a LEAP Challenge Grant to support undertaking this endeavor.


