RESOLUTION CONFIRMING ACCEPTANCE OF WORK AS COMPLETE 2023 REDEVELOPMENT OF WELL NO. 8

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City in the County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey authorized the award of contract on September 7, 2023 by Resolution #204-2023 to A.C. Schultes, Inc, 646 S. Evergreen Ave., Woodbury Heights, NJ 08097, as per their bid proposal for 2023 Redevelopment of Well No. 8 in an amount of \$122,200; and

WHEREAS, Edward Dennis, City Engineer, has advised in a letter dated February 13, 2024 that the work is completed; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to establish a date of acceptance of work as complete and to authorize the submission of a Maintenance Bond by the aforesaid contractor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, in the County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey that it does hereby confirm and otherwise accept as complete the 2023 Redevelopment of Well No. 8 in an amount of \$77,282.00.

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED that the contractor A.C. Schultes, Inc, 646 S. Evergreen Ave., Woodbury Heights, NJ 08097, is now hereby authorized to post a Maintenance Bond in said amount of \$77,282.00, which represents 100% of the total construction costs; said Bond to be in effect for a period of two years from the date of acceptance hereby established as of January 1, 2024.


