

RESOLUTION #86-2022
AUTHORIZING CHANGE ORDER #2 (DECREASE)
2021 REDEVELOPMENT OF WELL NO. 5

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, in the County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey has on May 5, 2021 approved Resolution #136-2021 awarding a contract to Uni-Tech Drilling Co., Inc., 61 Grays Ferry Road, Franklinville, NJ 08322, as per their bid proposal for the 2021 Redevelopment of Well No. 5 Project in an amount not to exceed \$128,850.00; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer, Edward Dennis, has prepared a letter dated December 20, 2021 regarding Change Order #1 that related to a change in contract due to material delivery time providing for an extension of seventy-four (74) days, resulting in a new contract completion date of one hundred nineteen days (119); and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer, Edward Dennis, has prepared a letter dated March 23, 2022 regarding Change Order #2 that related to a change in contract due to Final As-Built Quantities, resulting in a decrease contract amount (\$60,850.00) resulting in a new contract amount of \$66,640.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, in the County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey does hereby authorize the issuance of Change Order #2 to the contract for 2021 Redevelopment of Well No. 5 with Uni-Tech Drilling Co., Inc., 61 Grays Ferry Road, Franklinville, NJ 08322 in the amount of \$66,640.00.


