**RESOLUTION CONFIRMING ACCEPTANCE OF  
WORK AS COMPLETE  
2021 REDEVELOPMENT OF WELL NO. 5**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey authorized Resolution #136-2021 on June 17, 2021 awarding a contract to Uni-Tech Drilling Company, Inc., 61 Grays Ferry Road, Franklinville, NJ 08322 as per their proposal for the 2021 Redevelopment of Well No. 5, in an amount of \$128,850.00; and

**WHEREAS**, Edward Dennis, City Engineer, has advised in a letter dated March 1, 2022 that the work is completed; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body desires to establish a date of acceptance of work as complete and to authorize the submission of a Maintenance Bond by the aforesaid contractor.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, in the County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey that it does hereby confirm and otherwise accept as complete the 2021 Redevelopment of Well No. 5 in the final contract amount of \$68,000.00.

**BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED**, that the contractor Uni-Tech Drilling Company, Inc., 61 Grays Ferry Road, Franklinville, NJ 08322 is now hereby authorized to post a Maintenance Bond in said amount of \$68,000.00, which represents 100% of the total construction costs; said Bond to be in effect for a period of two years from the date of acceptance hereby established as of March 1, 2022.
