# CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY INSPECTION REQUIREMENTS FOR RENTALS AND SALES

# **SMOKE DETECTORS**

All smoke alarms shall be installed as follows:

- 1. On each level of the premises.
- 2. In <u>every</u> bedroom.
- 3. Outside of each separate sleeping area with a maximum distance of (10) ten feet from doorways.

<u>\*\*NEW Requirements:</u> As of January 1, 2019: A Ten-year sealed lithium battery-powered single station smoke alarm shall be installed and listed in accordance with ANSI/UL 217. Exception: All existing A/C-powered smoke alarms shall be accepted as meeting the requirements- DO NOT REMOVE.

### CARBON MONOXIDE ALARMS

Carbon monoxide alarms shall be installed as follows:

- 1. On each level of the premises.
- 2. In the immediate vicinity/outside of hallways of <u>all</u> sleeping areas.
- 3. Carbon monoxide alarms may be battery-operated, hard-wired or of the plug-in type and shall be listed and labeled.

# **GFCI OUTLETS**

Please be advised, Ground Fault Circuit Interrupters Outlets shall be installed as follows:

- 1. All kitchen and bathroom counters.
- 2. All outlets within (6) six feet of a utility sink and/or a wet bar.
- 3. All garage and exterior outlets.

# FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

A portable fire extinguisher shall be installed in accordance with the following:

- 1. Within (10) ten feet of the kitchen area and located in a path of egress;
- 2. Readily accessible, not obstructed from view and **mounted** using the manufacturer's hanging bracket so the operating instructions are clearly visible;
- 3. Approved listed and labeled type with a minimum rating of <u>2A-10B:C</u> and no more than 10 pounds;
- 4. The owner's manual or written operation instructions shall be provided during the inspection and left for the new occupant;
- 5. The top of the extinguisher shall not be more than (5) five feet above the floor.
