The construction will include installation of scaffold and a containment system, removal of the existing paint and repainting the tank. Benson Avenue will be closed between Monmouth Avenue and Winchester Avenue during construction.

The contract for this work has been awarded to Allied Tank Painting, Inc., Cherry Hill, NJ (856-429-3400). They expect to begin work on Monday, **October 14, 2019**. Work hours are 7:00 AM-3:30 PM Monday thru Friday. Parking will not be permitted on the street in the area of construction during work hours. Should damages occur to your property, please call me in our office. Because this is a large construction project and scaffolding must be installed, there will be inconveniences.

We anticipate that this project will be complete before the end of the year.
